LAST DAY TO REGISTER FOR THE **PRIMARY ELECTION IS AUGUST 15, 2008**

LAST DAY TO REGISTER FOR THE **GENERAL ELECTION IS OCTOBER 10, 2008**

The General Office at 32 Broadway, NYC 10004, 7th floor, will be open until midnight on August 15, 2008 and October 10, 2008 to receive last minute registrations.

PLEASE NOTE: If a voter, registered in New York City, moves WITHIN the City and fails to re-register from his new address BEFORE the cut off date OR, if the voter moves WITHIN NYC AFTER the deadline to register, he/she should go to his NEW polling site on election day and vote on an affidavit ballot. His/her name will not appear in the poll list book, hence the affidavit ballot.

.If you don't receive an Acknowledgment from the Board of Elections that your registration was received within 20 days after submission of registration form, please call TOLL FREE FOR NYC RESIDENTS 1-(866) V-O-T-E-N-Y-C (1-866-868-3692), OR 1 (212) V-O-T-E-N-Y-C (outside NYC) or your local Board of Elections to verify that your application was received and processed.

ABSENTEE BALLOT APPLICATIONS

PRIMARY

1. A written request for an absentee ballot APPLICATION for the September Primary Election must be postmarked no later than September 2, 2008.
2. The last day to personally deliver an absentee ballot APPLICATION to the borough office for the Primary is September 8, 2008

GENERAL

1. A written request for an absentee ballot APPLICATION for the General Election must be postmarked no later than October 28, 2008
2. The last day to personally deliver an absentee ballot APPLICATION to the borough office for the General Election is November 3, 2008

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

SEPTEMBER PRIMARY - Ballot must be postmarked no later than September 8, 2008. An Absentee Ballot may be delivered to the borough office for a voter who, because of illness, travel, etc. is unable to vote at the polls, no later than 9 PM on September 9, 2008.

GENERAL ELECTION - Ballot must be postmarked no later than November 3, 2008

An Absentee Ballot may be delivered to the borough office for a voter who, because of illness, travel, etc. is unable to vote at the polls, no later than 9 PM on November 4, 2008

CHANGE OF ENROLLMENT

LAST DAY TO CHANGE ENROLLMENT IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE IN THE SEPTEMBER 2008 PRIMARY ELECTION WAS OCTOBER 12, 2007.

PETITIONS

SEPTEMBER PRIMARY First day to sign designating petitions for the September Primary is June 3, 2008
Dates for filing designating petitions for the September Primary are July 7-July10, 2008

GENERAL ELECTION First day to sign independent nomination petitions for the General Election is July 8, 2008
Dates for filing independent nominating petitions for the November General Election are August 12-19, 2008
