

SPECIAL BALLOT FOR POLL WORKERS

The Special Poll Worker absentee application may be submitted once they have been assigned to work at a Poll Site different from their home ED/AD.

To receive their ballot they have two options. The first option is to have their ballot mailed no earlier than 14 days prior to the election (11-302-NYS Election Law). If they choose this option, they must bring their voted ballot sealed in the absentee envelope to the Poll Site in which they work. Be sure the envelope is signed by the Inspector at the Poll Site they are working and place it in the Return Envelope.

The second option is they may vote in person at the Borough Office not earlier than 14 days prior to the election (11-302-NYS Election Law). It must be returned on Election Day at the Poll Site in which the Poll Worker worked and the envelope must be signed by the Inspector at the Poll Site they are working and place it in the Return Envelope.
