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### **Frequently Asked Questions regarding Ballot Marking Devices (BMDs) for Fall 2008 and 2009**

#### **4. Who can use a BMD in the NYC 2008 and 2009 Primary and General Elections?**

For the General Election, any voter registered in the City of New York may use a BMD to vote in the poll site where they regularly vote.

For the Primary Election, any voter enrolled in a political party conducting a primary may use a BMD to vote in the poll site where they regularly vote.

HAVA does not provide a definition for disability, so any voter may use a BMD to prepare his/her ballot though voters should be aware that use of the audio ballot feature could require as much as 15 - 45 minutes to listen and cast a ballot.
