Become an Election Day Interpreter

The Board of Elections in the City of New York is recruiting bilingual residents fluent in Spanish, Chinese or Korean to serve as paid interpreters on Election Day.

Why Serve as an Election Day Interpreter?

- **Get paid up to \$460** for your service for working both Elections and completing training
- Gain an opportunity to assist and serve members of **your community**

To serve as an interpreter you must:

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Be a resident of New York City
- Be fluent in English and the identified language
- Successfully complete the interpreter training program and pass exam
- Be willing to travel within your borough to your assigned poll site
- Be able to work on Primary Day, September 13th and/or Election Day, November 8th

Please note that per the Internal Revenue Service, all interpreters are considered employees on the day of service and are required to fill out a W-4 form.
